General Information

What is the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master CCD-STeDe?

From the A.Y. 2023/24 the International Master on Climate Change and Diversity: Sustainable Territorial Development has been awarded as an **Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree by the European Commission.**

CCD-STeDe is a world leading programme in the field of sustainable territorial development in the context of climate justice. It is a **2-year Master Degree course** (120 ECTS credits).

The CCD- STeDe programme requires **3 semester of international mobility in different parts of the World**, among which 2 have to be different from the student's residence country. It trains researchers and professionals in supporting organizations acting in the territory (enterprises, local communities, civil society organizations) and in drafting sustainable development and climate adaptation policies for economic, social, environmental, international and intercultural management.

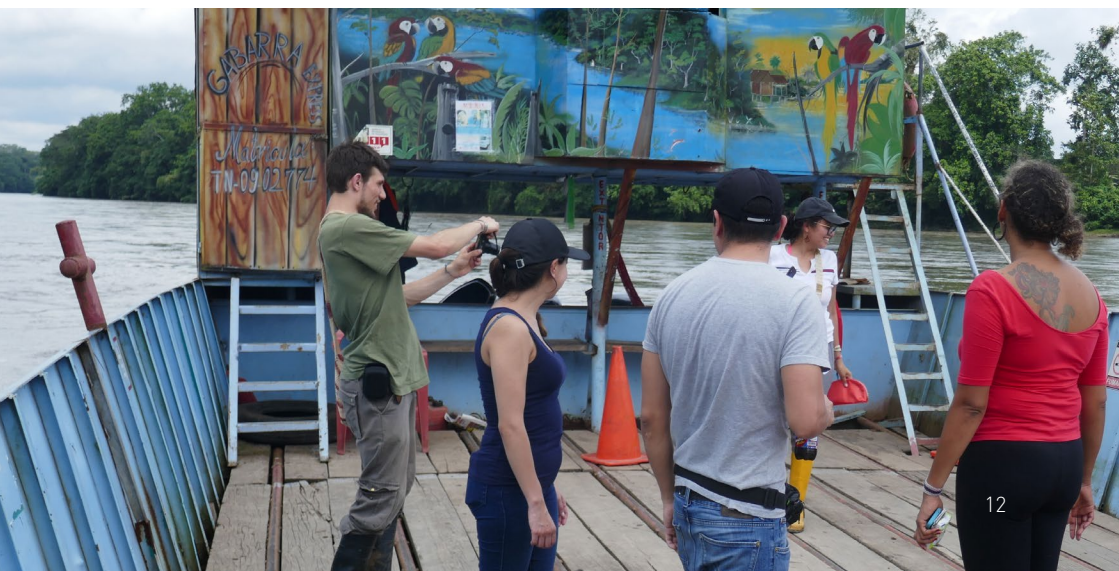
Topics of the Master

The Master concerns alternatives to development, sustainable development, climate justice, social inclusion, environmental protection, international cooperation, circular, and solidarity economy. It analyses intercultural relation challenges of territorial development focusing not only on local communities, but also on enterprises, non-state actors, civil society organizations, regional and international organizations.

The programme can be attended **only on a full-time basis**.

Attending lectures is compulsory.

Teaching languages are **English** as first language and a second language to choose among **Spanish**, **Portuguese**, or **French**.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND ENROLLMENT

Admission requirements

CCD-STeDe Erasmus Mundus Joint Master is **open to worldwide candidates**.

Candidates are required to have:

- **first cycle academic degree of at least 3 years - 180 ECTS credits** (Licenciatura, Academic Bachelor degree, Diploma di Laurea di primo livello, Licence) or an equivalent degree (Diplôme d'École d'Ingénieurs, Ecole de Commerce etc.), obtained **by June 30 2023** and officially recognized by the national law;
- good command of **English and Spanish or Portuguese or French**, both spoken and written
A good command of the chosen path's second language is required to be eligible. Please consider it for your choice;
- personal interest in **sustainable development**.

Language certificates are not required to be eligible to participate in Master Programme but supply a detailed description of your language abilities, following the form available on the website.

If pre-selected your language proficiency in both English and Spanish or French or Portuguese will be verified during a Zoom Interview.

Erasmus Mundus scholarships

The EMJMD scholarship covers the **entire duration of the Master (24 months)**, through a **monthly allowance** of 1,400 euros. Students with scholarships will have covered the **tuition fees and insurance** for the entire duration of the Master.

The scholarship allows students to cover the costs implicated in the Erasmus Mundus Programme, for example:

- > Visa,
- > Travel costs,
- > Installation and subsistence costs (food and accommodation),
- > All other costs.

20 Erasmus Mundus scholarships are available: approximately 5 scholarships/each academic path.

The number can slightly vary depending on the number of enrolled students.



Self-financed students

For self-financed students (not selected for the EM scholarship), the participation costs/"tuition fees" are:

- > 4,000 €/Academic Year | **EU Applicants**
- > 7,000 € /Academic Year | for **non-EU Applicants**

- * For non-EU Applicants belonging from countries of partner universities, Andean Community (Ecuador, Peru, Colombia, Bolivia), South Africa and Burkina Faso, tuition fees will be 4,000 € /Academic Year.

! For 11 students not benefiting from the EM scholarship, the consortium foresees to give **partial support and fee waiver**.

TOTAL PLACES AVAILABLE

The **total places available are 55**, distributed among the academic paths:

- > Path 1: 15 places
- > Path 2: 10 places
- > Path 3: 15 places
- > Path 4: 15 places

Students services

- **Administrative support** for enrolment at each Universities (Visa, accommodation, academic and administrative support from application to graduation);
- Personalised didactic support for students with special needs;
- **Dedicated Tutor/Buddies**;
- **Welcome week** with a kick-off seminars during the first semester;
- **Free basic courses of national language/culture**;
- **Student insurance covering health and travels for 24 + 2 months**, both to students with scholarships and self-sponsored.
